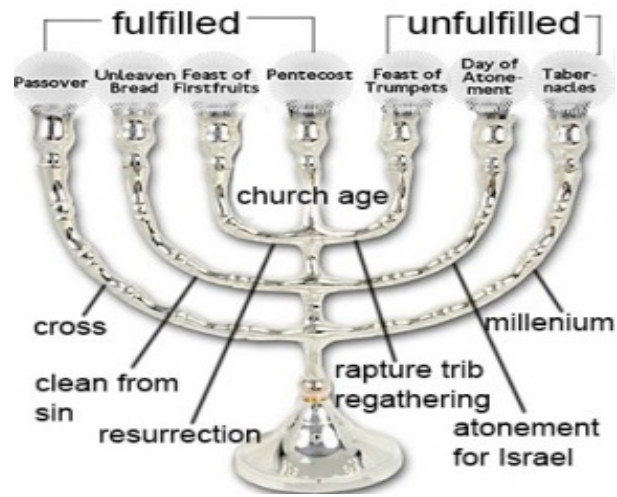

## The Feast of Trumpets is

### "The Day No Man Knows the Hour"

We are searching the scriptures to show ourselves approved! The Fall Festivals of the Lord are given to us as themes to teach the Second Coming of the Lord Jesus and are taught by The Spirit of God throughout the Old Testament, by Yeshua and His disciples throughout the New Testament, and then put in chronological order in the Book of Blessing, Revelation!



Jesus fulfills the WORD. He came on time on the Spring Festivals in His 1<sup>st</sup> Coming!

On Passover - He offered Himself as the sinless Lamb of God.

His precious Blood was poured out on our behalf to atone forever for our sins

On Unleavened Bread - His Burial removed our sins outside the camp!

On Firstfruits - the 1<sup>st</sup> Sabbath after His death resurrected as the Firstfruits offering!

On Pentecost - 50 days from Firstfruits, The Holy Spirit came in power exactly on time!  
3000 were saved and the Church was birthed!

Now we look expectantly to the Calendar of God again! He Will Come Again on time

### "Watch and Pray"

So many times in the Bible we are warned to "watch and pray". The Spirit of God will help us to meditate, study, and understand His Word. The Holy Spirit will also help us grasp the themes of the Festivals of the Lord which is the prophetic calendar of our Messiah. We can then watch over the world events according to the Scripture. By watching these things come to pass, we will be on our knees praying, asking for boldness to witness so that others might come to the truth, and daily searching our hearts to make sure that we are not caught up in the snares of the devil by living like the world. The WORD declares we can know the season of His return! We can escape all these things that shall come to pass by watching and praying!

Luke 21: 34, 35 "And take heed, (be watchful) to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day (The Day of the Lord) comes on you unaware (The Day no man knows the hour)...For as a snares, shall it (The Day of the Lord) come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth." (The earth dwellers are not only unbelievers, but apostate church members who are peace activists! - 1 Thess. 5)

Luke 21:36 "Watch therefore and pray always, that you may be counted worthy to escape all these things, (kairos = the appointed times = moedim = the fall festivals) that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of Man!

We are to watch (know) the Calendar of God (The Festivals of the LORD) and to pray!

We are also to watch and pray over our own lives to live holy and righteous!

## "No Man Knows the Day of the Hour"

The 3 Fall Festivals start on the first day signified by the new moon in the 7<sup>th</sup> Month of Tishrei. This is the only Holy Day marked by the New Moon and is set apart for that reason as special. All other festivals are set or counted by the full moon so The Spirit of GOD is pointing to this festival as a certain day! (Passover, Unleavened Bread, Firstfruits, and even Pentecost are counted from the Full Moon in Nissan!)

### God Counts Prophetic Time in the Bible on a Jewish Calendar!

A new moon is called "rosh chodesh" in Hebrew. New Moons must be validated in Israel by 2 witnesses who will watch the dark black sky at the end of the moon cycle for the first glimmer of the moon to reappear. This is the beginning of the 30 day cycle which determines Israel's months. (Moon is the word from which we get months). As soon as the new moon is sighted and verified (2 witnesses) the Sanhedrin, or the High Priest will send runners with signal lights rapidly to the east and to the west "like lightning."

### "The Lightning from the East to the West" is a Hebrew idiom for the Feast of Trumpets!

Matthew 24:27 "For as the lightning comes out of the east, and shines even unto the west; so shall also the coming of the Son of man be."

Luke 10:18 "And He said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven."

Luke 17:24 "For as the lightning, that lightens out of the one part under heaven, shines unto the other part under heaven (the east to the west); so shall also the Son of man be in his day."

Psalms 103:12 "As far as the east is from the west (Ma'arab), so far has He removed our transgressions from us." This is a Hebrew idiom for the Day He will come to cleanse Israel as a nation!

Psalms 18:11-14 "He made darkness (the new moon on Feast of Trumpets) His secret place (the day no man knows the hour); His pavilion round about Him were dark waters and thick clouds of the skies (describing the Day of the Lord). At the brightness that was before Him his thick clouds passed, hail stones and coals of fire. The LORD also thundered in the heavens, and the Highest gave His voice (the sound of the trumpet - the shofar); hail stones and coals of fire. Yea, He sent out His arrows, and scattered them; and He shot out lightnings, and discomfited them." All describing the Day of the Lord on The Feast of Trumpets as the lightning!

Psalms 77:18 "The voice of Your thunder was in the heaven (the shofar): the lightnings lightened the world: the earth trembled and shook." Festival of Trumpets!

Psalms 97:4 "His lightnings enlightened the world: the earth saw, and trembled."

Psalms 135:7 "He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes lightnings for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasures."

Jeremiah 10: 13 "When He utters His voice (the Shofar - the Last Trump), there is a multitude of waters in the Heavens, and He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes lightnings with rain, and brings forth the wind out of His treasures."

Jeremiah 51:16 "When He utters His voice (the Trumpet of God), there is a multitude of waters in the heavens; and He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth: he makes lightnings with rain, and brings forth the wind out of his treasures."

Nahum 2:4 “The Chariots shall rage in the streets, they shall justle one against another in the broad ways: they shall seem like torches, they shall run like the lightnings.” Festival of Trumpets Again!

Job 38:35 “Can you send lightnings, that they may go and say unto you, Here we are?”

Revelation 8:5 “And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire of the altar, and cast it into the earth: and there were voices (Trumpets), and thundering (Shofar), and lightnings, and an earthquake.”

Revelation 11:19 “And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in His temple the ark of His testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunders, and an earthquake, and great hail.”

Revelation 16:18 “And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.”

Luke 2:32 “A light to lighten the Gentiles, and the glory of Your people Israel.” This was prophesied by Simeon in the Temple of Jesus who was born during the Fall Festivals.

Revelation 21:23 “And the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light thereof.”

From One End of Heaven to the Other is the Same as From the East to the West!!

Matthew 24:31 “And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.” On Yom Teruah!

**Jesus is the Light! He Comes as the Light in the Midst of Darkness!**

John 1:5 “And the light shines in darkness; and the darkness comprehends it not.” Jesus Comes as the New Moon on the day that no one knows.

The Fall Feasts Explain the Themes of the Second Coming of the Messiah

The Believers who study and understand the Holy Days and their prophetic themes will know the Day as the Feast of Trumpets; the unbelievers and those who do not study will not know the day, they will be “in the dark”. The Feast of Trumpets introduces Yom Kippur and then the Feast of Tabernacles! The Second Coming in the Fall Festivals is the Resurrection of the Living and the Dead (Rapture) on Yom Teruah, the Tribulation poured out and Jesus’ 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming as Yom Kippur, and the Millennial Reign of Christ on Earth as Sukkot, the Feast of Tabernacles!

## Teaching on the Day No One Knows the Hour in the Bible = The New Moon

Amos 5:20 "Shall not the day of the LORD be darkness, and not light? even very dark, and no brightness in it?"

Proverbs 7:18-20 "Come, let us take our fill of love until the morning: let us solace ourselves with loves. For the Goodman (Jesus) is not at home, He is gone a long journey: He has taken a bag of money with Him, and will come home at the day appointed." (Keseh - the hidden moon)

Mark 13:34 "For the Son of Man is as a man taking a far journey, who left His house, and gave authority to His servants, and to every man His work, and commanded the porter to watch."

Matthew 25:14-15 "For the Kingdom of Heaven is as a man travelling into a far country, who called His own servants, and delivered unto them His goods. And unto one He gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according to his several ability; and straightway took His journey."

Matthew 20:1,11 "For the Kingdom of Heaven is like unto a man that is an householder, which went out early in the morning to hire laborers into His vineyard. And when they had received it, they murmured against the Goodman of the House,"

Revelation 3:1-3 "And unto the angel of the church in Sardis write; These things says He that has the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know your works, that you have a name that you live, and are dead. Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are ready to die: for I have not found your works perfect before God. Remember therefore how you have received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. If therefore you shall not watch, I will come on you as a thief, and you shall not know what hour I will come upon you."

Matthew 25:8-13 "And the foolish said unto the wise, Give us of your oil; for our lamps are gone out. But the wise answered, saying, Not so; lest there be not enough for us and you: but go rather to them that sell, and buy for yourselves. And while they went to buy, the bridegroom came; and they that were ready went in with Him to the marriage: and the door was shut. Afterward came also the other virgins, saying, Lord, Lord, open to us. But He answered and said, Verily I say unto you, I know you not. Watch therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour wherein the Son of Man comes."

Luke 12: 37-41 "Blessed are those servants, whom the Lord when He comes shall find watching: verily I say unto you, that He shall gird Himself, and make them to sit down to meat, and will come forth and serve them. And if He shall come in the second watch, or come in the third watch, and find them so, blessed are those servants. And this know, that if the Goodman of the House had known what hour the thief would come, He would have watched, and not have suffered his house to be broken through. Be therefore ready also: for the Son of Man comes at an hour when you think not. Then Peter said unto him, Lord, do you speak this parable unto us, or even to all?"

Luke 12:42-46 "And the Lord said, Who then is that faithful and wise steward, whom his Lord shall make ruler over His household, to give them their portion of meat in due season? Blessed is that servant, whom his Lord when He cometh shall find so doing. Of a truth I say unto you, that He will make Him ruler over all that He hath. But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delays His coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken; The Lord of that servant will come in a day when he looks not for Him, and at an hour when he is not aware, and will cut him in sunder, and will appoint him his portion with the unbelievers."

Matthew 16:3 "And in the morning, It will be foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowering. O you hypocrites, you can discern the face of the sky; but can you not discern the signs of the times?" (You do not know the day or the hours of the moedim - the Holy Days, the Festivals)

Matthew 24:43-44 “But know this, that if the Goodman of the house had known in what watch the thief would come, he would have watched, and would not have suffered his house to be broken up. Therefore be you also ready: for in such an hour as you think not the Son of Man comes.”

Matthew 24:50 “The Lord of that servant shall come in a day when he looks not for Him, and in an hour that he is not aware of,” No man knows the Day or the Hour is Tom Teruah! Feast of Trumpets!

Luke 19: 41,42,44 “And when He was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it, Saying, If you had known, even you, at least in this your day, the things which belong unto your peace! but now they are hid from your eyes. And shall lay you even with the ground, and your children within you; and they shall not leave in you one stone upon another; because you knew not the time of your visitation.”

1 Thessalonians 5:1-4 “But of the times (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Coming) and the seasons (moedim), brethren, you have no need that I write unto you. For yourselves know perfectly that the day of the Lord so comes as a thief in the night. For when they shall say, Peace and safety; then sudden destruction comes upon them, as travail upon a woman with child; and they shall not escape. But you, brethren, are not in darkness, that that Day should overtake you as a thief.” **You will know!**

Acts 1:7-8 “And He said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father has put in His own power. But you shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and you shall be witnesses unto Me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.”

### Getting Your House in Order is Hebrew Idiom for Getting Ready for Yom Teruah!

Luke 12:39-40 already quoted in this study!

Mark 13:32-37 “But of that day and that hour knows no man, no, not the angels which are in heaven, neither the Son, but the Father. Take heed, **watch and pray**: for you know not when the time is. For the Son of Man is as a man taking a far journey, who left His house, and gave authority to His servants, and to every man His work, and commanded the porter to watch. Watch therefore: for you know not when the master of the house comes, at even, or at midnight, or at the cockcrowing, or in the morning: Lest coming suddenly He find you sleeping. And what I say unto you I say unto all, **Watch.**”

Revelation 9:15 “And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.” Continuation of Revelation 6:1-2 and Daniel 7:2

### “The Twinkling of an Eye” Festival of the New Moon!

1 Corinthians 15:52 “In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.”

The new moon conjunction when the moon is dark is known as the twinkling of an eye;  
the moon blinks!
