Walking in Perfect Peace of the Storm

SHALOM שָׁלוֹם

Every Hebrew word is made up of usually 3 consonants that explain the spiritual principle of the word itself. Let's look at Shalom, which comes from the root SHALAM.

Shin (all consuming, destroying) Lamed (the Authority) Mem (chaos, water)

Shalom is what destroys the authority of chaos in our lives!

Shalom takes it one step further... Shin ש Lamed ל Vav ו Mem מ

Destroy the authority that establishes chaos: Deal with the ROOT ISSUES!
The Vav means hooked to the chaos! Some things have to be cut off!

The Biblical pattern for PEACE on the inside of us includes healing in every area of our life, which only can be done by:

- Understanding the unconditional love of the FATHER,
- Accepting fully the blood covenant of the SON
- Yielding (fearlessly) to the leading of the Holy Spirit to teach and guide us!

The ROOTS have to be dealt with!

Psalm 119 teaches the Hebrew Alphabet! Every 8 verses introduces one of the 22 Hebrew letters in exact order of the alphabet. The first word of every verse starts with that same Hebrew letter. As we study this amazing TRUTH of what GOD wants to do in us, we are building on the Hebrew primer in 8 verses in Psalms 119:161-168). Each verse starts with the letter SHEN. WHEN we can get this solid foundation deep in our spirit man, the SHALOM of GOD will see us through difficulties, brokenness, feelings of hopelessness and helplessness and SHALOM will be in us!

119:161 "Princes (tzar – enemies) persecute me without cause,
but my heart stands in awe of THY WORDS"

119:162 "I rejoice at Thy WORD, as one who finds great spoil (treasure)"

119:163 "I hate (sinah) and despise falsehood, but I LOVE THY LAW (Torah)"

119:164 "Seven times a day I PRAISE you, because of your righteous ordinances"

119:165 "Those who LOVE your law (Torah) have great Peace (SHALOM)
and nothing can stumble them"

119:166 "I hope for your SALVATION (YESHUA),
O LORD, and do your commandments."

119:167 "My soul keeps your testimonies, and I love them exceedingly"

119:168 "I keep your precepts and your Testimonies, for all my ways are before You'
