Isaiah Chapter 14 - "Lucifer, The Assyrian & The Islamic Anti-Christ"

¹ For the Lord will have mercy on Jacob, and will yet choose Israel, and set them in their own land: and the strangers shall be joined with them and they shall cleave to the house of Jacob.





- ² And the people shall take them, and bring them to their place: and the house of Israel shall possess them in the land of the Lord for servants and handmaids: and they shall take them captives, whose captives they were; and they shall rule over their oppressors.
- ³ And it shall come to pass in the Day that the Lord shall give you rest from your sorrow, and from your fear, and from the hard bondage wherein you were made to serve,
- ⁴ That you shalt take up this proverb against the king of Babylon, and say, How has the oppressor ceased! How has the golden city ceased!



⁵ The Lord has broken the staff of the wicked, and the scepter of the rulers.

- ⁹ Hell from beneath is moved for you to meet you at your coming: it stirs up the dead for you, even all the chief ones of the earth; it has raised up from their thrones all the kings of the nations.
- ¹⁰ All they shall speak and say to you, Are you also become weak as us? Are you become like unto us?
- ¹¹ Your pomp is brought down to the grave, and the noise of your viols: the worm is spread under you, and the worms cover you.
- ¹² How are you fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! How are you cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.

¹⁵ Yet you shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.

- 16 They that see you shall narrowly look on you, and consider you, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;
- ¹⁷ That made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; that opened not the house of his prisoners?
- ¹⁸ All the kings of the nations, even all of them, lie in glory, every one in his own house.
- ¹⁹ But you are cast out of your grave like an abominable branch, and as the raiment of those that are slain, thrust through with a sword, that go down to the stones of the pit; as a carcass trodden under feet.





- ²⁰ You shall not be joined with them in burial, because you hast destroyed your land, and slain your people: the seed of evildoers shall never be renowned.



- The Anti-Christ will be worshipped on the Temple Mt. Where the Dome sits






Ezekiel Chapter 28

- ¹ The Word of the Lord came again to me, saying,
- ²Son of man, say to the prince of Tyrus, Thus says the Lord God; Because your heart is lifted up, and you have said, I am a God, I sit in the seat of God, in the midst of the seas; yet you are a man, and not God, though you set your heart as the heart of God:
- ³ Behold, you are wiser than Daniel; there is no secret that they can hide from you:
- ⁴With your wisdom and with your understanding you hast gotten you riches, and have gotten gold and silver into your treasures:
- ⁵ By your great wisdom and by your traffic have you increased your riches, and your heart is lifted up because of your riches:
- ⁶Therefore thus says the Lord God; Because you hast set your heart as the heart of God;
- ⁷Behold, therefore I will bring strangers on you, the terrible of the nations: and they shall draw their swords against the beauty of your wisdom, and they shall defile your brightness.
- ⁸They shall bring you down to the pit, and you shalt die the deaths of them that are slain in the midst of the seas.
- ⁹ Will you yet say before him that slays you, I am God? But you shall be a man, and no God, in the hand of him that slays you.
- ¹⁰You shall die the deaths of the uncircumcised by the hand of strangers: for I have spoken it, says the Lord God.
- ¹¹ Moreover the word of the Lord came to me, saying,
- ¹² Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say to him, Thus says the Lord God; Thou seals up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.
- ¹³ You have been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was your covering: the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of your tabrets and of your pipes was prepared in you in the day that you were created.
- ¹⁴You are the anointed cherub that covers; and I have set you so: you were upon the holy Mountain of God; you have walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire.
- $^{15}\mbox{You}$ were perfect in your ways from the day that you were created, till iniquity was found in you.

- ¹⁶ By the multitude of your merchandise they have filled the midst of you with violence, and you have sinned: therefore I will cast you as profane out of the Mountain of God: and I will destroy you, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire.
- ¹⁷Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty, you hast corrupted your wisdom by reason of your brightness: I will cast you to the ground, I will lay you before kings, that they may behold you.
- ¹⁸ You hast defiled your sanctuaries by the multitude of your iniquities, by the iniquity of your traffic; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of you, it shall devour you, and I will bring you to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold you.
- ¹⁹ All they that know you among the people shall be astonished at you: you shalt be a terror (ballahah), and never shall you be any more.
- ²⁰ Again the word of the Lord came to me, saying,
- ²¹ Son of man, set your face against Zidon, and prophesy against it,
- ²² And say, Thus says the Lord God; Behold, I am against you, O Zidon; and I will be glorified in the midst of you: and they shall know that I am the Lord, when I shall have executed judgments in her, and shall be sanctified in her.
- ²³ For I will send into her pestilence, and blood into her streets; and the wounded shall be judged in the midst of her by the sword upon her on every side; and they shall know that I am the Lord.
- ²⁴ And there shall be no more a pricking brier unto the house of Israel, nor any grieving thorn of all that are round about them, that despised them; and they shall know that I am the Lord God.
- ²⁵ Thus says the Lord God; When I shall have gathered the house of Israel from the people among whom they are scattered, and shall be sanctified in them in the sight of the heathen, then shall they dwell in their land that I have given to My servant Jacob.
- ²⁶ And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yea, they shall dwell with confidence, when I have executed judgments upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that I am the Lord their God.

"Satan – His Beginning, His Kingdom, and His End "



We can uncover Satan's origin and destiny in the pages of the Bible!

1. In what state was the earth created? Genesis 1:1-2; Job 38:4-7; Psalm 104:30; I Corinthians 14:33.

Comment: God originally created the earth with such perfection and beauty that the angels shouted with joy! Our Creator does all things in perfect order and completes all His works in exquisite splendor. But Genesis 1:2 describes an earth so formless and chaotic that God had to refashion it before He could create humanity. It is probable that Lucifer was cast down to earth between Genesis 1:1 and Genesis 1:2, thereby causing perfection to become desolate and waste. We do know that he appears as the serpent in Eden in Genesis Chapter 3 in order to deceive Adam and Eve to sin. "Tohu v Bohu" is the Hebrew idiom for void and waste found in Genesis 1:2. Consider that satan's presence on earth must have happened before God brings order out of chaos in creation. Satan then has the ability to temporarily appear before God's throne to accuse Job. But in Revelation 12, the devil is cast down to the earth for his time is short. No longer can he approach God in the 3rd Heaven, but he can only occupy the 1st and 2nd heavens to deceive mankind. Finally he is judged and cast into the pit, forever sealed in the Lake of Fire forever. The "Tohu v Bohu" study found in 3 Scriptures: Genesis 1:2; Isaiah 34:11; and Jeremiah 4:23.

2. Who was Lucifer? Isaiah 14:12-15; Ezekiel 28:12-17.

Comment: "Lucifer" ("light-bringer" or "morning star," the Roman name for the planet Venus) is an unfortunate translation of the Hebrew word <u>helel</u>, which means "shining one." Ezekiel calls him "the anointed cherub who covers," which means he was one of the chief angels whose wings covered God's throne in heaven. The Word specifically shows him to be a created being, possibly the most beautiful, wise, and perfect of God's angelic creations, and a chief leader of worship.

But this mighty angel grew proud and vain in his beauty. He became envious of God's authority over the universe, and over countless years, he schemed to induce other angels to support him in overthrowing God. When he finally led 1/3 of the angels (Revelation 12:4) to war against God in heaven, God cast him and his angelic troops back to the earth (Luke 10:18).

3. How did Lucifer/Helel become Satan? Ezekiel 28:15-17.

God created Lucifer a perfect spirit being, but He also gave him free-moral agency, the freedom to choose to follow good or evil. He chose to rebel while in Heaven and in the glorious presence of God. With his fall, he becomes the serpent, satan, the Devil, also known as the <u>Adversary</u> and Accuser of the brethren. He allowed <u>sin</u> to mold his character. His rebellion against God sealed and hardened his evil nature, and now he opposes all that is good, right, and godly (<u>Matthew 13:38-39</u>; <u>I Peter 5:8</u>; <u>Revelation 9:11</u>; 12:9-10).

4. Are Satan and his demons bound to this earth? Il Peter 2:4; Jude 6.

When God cast them back down to earth, He placed restrictions on their powers and limited them to "their proper domain" or "first estate," that is, the earth. Here, they await their judgment for their rebellion. "Cast them down to hell" in <u>II Peter 2:4</u> is a rendering of a single verb in Greek, *tartaroo*, from the noun, *Tartarus*, a place of restraint for the wicked, a prison. Though Satan himself may appear before God's throne in heaven, he and his demons can do only what God allows (Job 1:6-12; 2:1-7).

5. Is Satan "the prince of the power of the air"? What does this mean? Ephesians 2:1-3.

By deceiving the minds of men, Satan has set "the course of this world" against God and His loving, giving way of life. As the prince of the power of the air, he broadcasts his evil, rebellious attitudes to all humanity, and except for a few whom God has called out of his deceptions, the whole world lives under his sway (I John 5:19; Revelation 12:9).

6. Has Satan been disqualified as ruler of this earth? <u>John 12:27-33</u>; <u>14:30</u>; <u>16:11</u>; <u>Colossians</u> <u>1:13</u>; <u>2:15</u>; <u>Hebrews 2:9</u>, <u>14-15</u>.

<u>Jesus Christ</u>, who is the Son of God, lived a perfect life as a sinless man and died for the sins of men, He qualified to dethrone Satan. The Adversary, who had the power of death, has been defeated! However, he remains active among us until the <u>King of Kings</u> returns and sets up His government on earth.

7. Will Satan attempt to ruin God's plan before Christ returns? Revelation 12:7-9, 12-17; 16:12-16; 19:17-21; 20:1-3.

The Devil will again go on the offensive against God with the same results: God casts him back down to earth. In his anger over his defeat, he will savagely persecute God's people and gather the armies of man to fight against Christ when He comes. He and his human agents will be soundly defeated, and a strong angel will imprison him in the bottomless pit for 1000 years.

8. What is Satan's ultimate fate? Revelation 20:7-10.

After 1000 years of imprisonment, Satan will be released for a short while. During his parole, he will again unite some of the nations and take them to war against God's people. But God will summarily end this rebellion by sending fire out of heaven to destroy his army. The Devil will then be sentenced and cast into the Lake of Fire to suffer and die for his iniquity. Finally, God and mankind will be forever rid of their chief enemy, and peace and righteousness will flourish for all eternity!

Bible Verses About the Devil

Genesis 3:1-5 1. Now the serpent was more crafty than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God really say, 'You must not eat from any tree in the garden'?" 2 The woman said to the serpent, "We may eat fruit from the trees in the garden, 3 but God did say, 'You must not eat fruit from the tree that is in the middle of the garden, and you must not touch it, or you will die.' " 4 "You will not certainly die," the serpent said to the woman. 5 "For God knows that when you eat from it your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil."

<u>Genesis 3:14-15</u> "And the Lord God said to the serpent, because you have done this, you are cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon your belly you shall go, and dust shall you eat all the days of your life. And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and her seed; he shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise his heel."

Job 1:6-12 "One day the angels came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan also came with them. 7 The LORD said to Satan, "Where have you come from?" Satan answered the LORD, "From roaming throughout the earth, going back and forth on it." 8 Then the LORD said to Satan, "Have you considered my servant Job? There is no one on earth like him; he is blameless and upright, a man who fears God and shuns evil." 9 "Does Job fear God for nothing?" Satan replied. 10 "Have you not put a hedge around him and his household and everything he has? You have blessed the work of his hands, so that his flocks and herds are spread throughout the land. 11 But now stretch out your hand and strike everything he has, and he will surely curse you to your face." 12 The LORD said to Satan, "Very well, then, everything he has is in your power, but on the man himself do not lay a finger." Then Satan went out from the presence of the LORD.

<u>1 Peter 5:8</u> - Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walks about, seeking whom he may devour:

<u>Luke 10:17-19</u> And the 70 returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through Your name. And He said to them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

- <u>Hebrews 2:14</u> Since therefore the children share in flesh and blood, he himself likewise partook of the same things, that through death he might destroy the one who has the power of death, that is, the dev
- <u>1 John 5:18-19</u> We know that whosoever is born of God sins not; but he that is begotten of God keeps (guards) himself, and that wicked one touches him not.
- <u>1 John 3:8</u> Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil
- James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.
- <u>John 8:44</u> You are of [your] father the devil, and the lusts of your father you will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaks a lie, he speaks of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

- <u>Luke 22:1-61</u> Now the Festival of Unleavened Bread, called the Passover, was approaching, **2** and the chief priests and the teachers of the law were looking for some way to get rid of Jesus, for they were afraid of the people. **3** Then Satan entered Judas, called Iscariot, one of the Twelve. **4** And Judas went to the chief priests and the officers of the temple guard and discussed with them how he might betray Jesus. **5** They were delighted and agreed to give him money. **6** He consented, and watched for an opportunity to hand Jesus over to them when no crowd was present.
- <u>1 Corinthians 7:5</u> "Do not deprive each other except perhaps by mutual consent and for a time, so that you may devote yourselves to prayer. Then come together again so that Satan will not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.
- <u>1 Corinthians 10:13</u> There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God [is] faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear [it].
- <u>2 Corin 4:4</u> In whom "the god of this world" has blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them
- <u>2 Corin 2:10-11</u> To whom ye forgive any thing, I forgive also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ; 11 Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices.
- <u>2 Corinthians 11:3</u> But I am afraid that just as Eve was deceived by the serpent's cunning, your minds may somehow be led astray from your sincere and pure devotion to Christ.
- 2 Corinthians 11:14 And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an angel of light.
- <u>Ephesians 2:2</u> Wherein in time past you walked according to the course of this world, according to "the prince of the power of the air," the spirit that now works in the children of disobedience:
- <u>Luke 22:31-32</u> And the Lord said, Simon, Simon, behold, Satan has desired [to have] you, that he may sift [you] as wheat:
- <u>Matthew 25:41</u> Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, you cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:
- <u>John 10:10</u> The thief comes not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly.
 - Acts 5:3 Then Peter said, "Ananias, how is it that Satan has so filled your heart that you have lied to the Holy Spirit and have kept for yourself some of the money you received for the land?
 - <u>Romans16:20</u> The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.
 - <u>James 1:13-15</u> Let no man say when he is tempted, I am tempted of God: for God cannot be tempted with evil, neither tempts He any man:

<u>Jude 1:9</u> But when the archangel Michael, contending with the devil, was disputing about the body of Moses, he did not presume to pronounce a blasphemous judgment, but said, "The Lord rebuke you."

<u>Revelation 12:4</u> His tail swept down 1/3 of the stars of heaven and cast them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she bore her child he might devour it


<u>Revelation 12:7</u> Now war arose in heaven, Michael and his angels fighting against the dragon. And the dragon and his angels fought back,

Revelation 12:9 - And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceives the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

<u>Revelation 20:10</u> - The devil that deceived them was cast into the Lake of Fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet [are], and shall be tormented day and night forever and ever.

<u>Revelation 21:8</u> - But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the Lake of Fire which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the 2nd Death.

- ¹⁰ Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of His might.
- ¹¹ Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.



For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

- ¹³Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, so that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.
- ¹⁴ Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with Truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;
- ¹⁵ And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;
- ¹⁶ Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith you shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.
- ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:
- ¹⁸ Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;
