Warning to Believers: Overwhelming Apostasy of End Times

About the end of the Church Age! We could call it -

"The Acts of the Apostates"

"The Absolute Assurance to the Faithful"

Apostasia "the falling away from truth, departure from faith, unwillingness to endure sound doctrine, false teachers & false prophets bringing damnable heresies"

- *Luke 18:8* "I tell you that He shall avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes back, will He find faith on the earth?"
- *2 Thess. 2:3* "Let no one deceive you by any means: for That Day shall not come, except there come a falling away first (*apostasia*) and that man of sin (anti-christ) be revealed, the "son of perdition"
- *1 Tim. 4:1-3* "Now the Holy Spirit speaks expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith (*apostasy*), giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils, speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their consciences seared with a hot iron; forbidding to marry, commanding to abstain from meats, which God has created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe & know the truth."
- *2 Tim. 4:2* "Preach the Word, be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering & doctrine, for the time will come when they won't endure sound doctrine, but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having "itching ears," & they shall turn away their ears from the truth, & shall be turned to fables."
- *2 Peter 2:1* "But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who secretly shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, & bring upon themselves swift destruction. And many shall follow their immoral ways & lascivious acts, because of them the Truth shall be evil spoken of. And through covetousness they shall with feigned words make merchandise of you: their judgment now of a long time lingers not, & their damnation does not slumber.
- *2 Peter 3:3* "Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, and saying "Where is the promise of His Coming? For all things continue as they were from the beginning.

Jesus' 2 half brothers contrast for us the blessing and the curse!

Book of James - good works are evidence of saving faith

Book of Jude - evil works are evident of apostasy from faith

(None of Jesus' 4 stepbrothers believed until after His Resurrection (*John 7:5; Mark 6:3*))

Jude

- 1 Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James,
to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, and called:
- 2 Mercy unto you, and peace, and love, be multiplied. *'grace and peace'*
- 3 Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write to you of the common salvation,
it was needful for me to write you, and exhort you that you should earnestly contend
for the faith which was once delivered to the saints. *"earnestly contend for the faith"*
- 4 For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation,
ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness,
and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 5 I will therefore put you *in remembrance*, though you once knew this, how that the Lord,
having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward *destroyed them that believed not*.
- 6 And the angels which kept not their 1st estate (heaven), but left their own habitation,
He has reserved in everlasting chains under darkness to the judgment of the Great Day.
- 7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrah, and the cities about them in like manner,
giving themselves over *to fornication*, and going after *strange flesh*,
they are set forth as *an example*, suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.
- 8 *Likewise also* these filthy dreamers defile the flesh, despise dominion, & speak evil of dignities.
- 9 Yet *Michael the archangel*, when contending with the devil he disputed about *the body of Moses*,
dared not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, The Lord rebuke you.
- 10 But these speak evil of those things which they know not:
but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.
- 11 Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, *"the way of Cain"*
and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, *'the error of Balaam for \$\$'*
and perished in the gainsaying of Core (Korah). *"the gainsaying of Korah"*

- 12 These are spots in your love feasts when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear:
clouds they are without water, carried about of winds; trees whose fruit withers, without fruit,
twice dead, plucked up by the roots; *“Clouds without water/ trees without fruit”*
- 13 Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; *“raging waves/wandering stars”*
wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.
- 14 And Enoch also, 7th from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, *“Enoch prophesied”*
Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of His saints,
- 15 To execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are *ungodly* among them
of all their *ungodly deeds* which they have *ungodly* committed, *“judgment of ungodly”*
and of all their hard speeches which *ungodly* sinners have spoken against Him.
- 16 These are *murmurers, complainers*, walking after their own lusts;
and their mouth *speaking great swelling words*,
having men's persons in *admiration because of advantage*.
- 17 But, beloved, *remember the words* which were spoken before of our Lord Jesus Christ's apostles,
- 18 How that they told you there should be *mockers* in the last time,
who should walk after their own ungodly lusts.
- 19 These be they who separate themselves, sensual, *having not the Spirit*.
- 20 But you, beloved, *building up yourselves* on your most holy faith, *praying in the Holy Ghost*,
- 21 Keep yourselves in the love of God, looking for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life.
- 22 And of some have compassion, making a difference:
- 23 Others save with fear, pulling them out of the fire; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.
- 24 Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling,
& to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy,
- 25 To the only wise God our Savior, be glory & majesty, dominion & power, both now & ever. Amen

Jude points out 3 groups for God's Corporate Punishment (5-7)

1. Ancient Israel (vs.5)
2. Angels (vs.6)
3. Sodom & Gomorrah (vs.7)

Israel's Apostasy (5) is Clear Warning for Us! 1 Corin. 10 (Parallel Passage)

- 1-4. Moreover brethren, I would not that you would be ignorant, how that all of our fathers were under the cloud and all passed through the sea (Red Sea). And all were baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea. And did all eat the same spiritual meat (the manna). And did all drink the same spiritual drink: for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them &h that Rock was Christ.
5. But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.
- 6-8 Now these things were our examples, to the intent that we should not lust after evil things, as they lusted. Neither be *idolaters*, as were some of them: as it is written, the people sat down to eat & drink, and rose up to play (Ex. golden calf, naked immorality). Neither let us commit *fornication*, as some of them committed, and 23,000 fell in one day. (Num. 25)
- 9-10 Neither let us put Christ to the test, as some were also tempted, and were destroyed of serpents. (Num. 21- they complained about the manna). Neither murmur, as some of them also murmured & were destroyed of *the destroyer* (satan).
- 11-14 Now all of these things happened to them for examples and they were written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the earth are come. Wherefore let him that thinks he stands take heed, lest he fall. There has no temptation taken you but such is as common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted about what you are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that you may be able to bear it. Wherefore, my dearly beloved, flee from idolatry

What About the Angels' Apostasy?

1. Lucifer (Genesis 3:15, Isaiah 14:4-23; Ezekiel 28:1-19, Revelation 12) "*seed of serpent*"
2. Sons of God cohabit with daughters of men (Gen 6, 1 Cor. 11:10) "*Sons of god /daughters of men*"
3. Angels bound under Euphrates River (Rev. 16:12-14)
4. Principalities, powers, rulers of darkness of this world, spiritual wickedness in high places (Eph 6:10-18)

Hebrews Chapter 3

(Parallel passages for Israel's Apostasy)

7-9. Wherefore (as the Holy Ghost says) today if you will hear his voice, harden not your hearts, as in the provocation, in the day of temptation in the wilderness, when your fathers tempted Me, proved Me, and saw My works for 40 years.

10 -11. Wherefore I was grieved with that generation & said, 'They do always err in their heart & they have not known My ways. So I swore in My wrath, they shall not enter into My rest (Millennial Kingdom).

Paul quoting directly Psalms 95:8-11

12-13. Take heed brethren, lest there be in you any an evil heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God (apostasy). But exhort one another daily, while it is called Today, lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin.

14. For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast until the end. While it is said, Today if you will hear His voice, harden not your hearts, as in the day of provocation.

15-19. For some, when they heard, did provoke: howbeit all that came out of Egypt by Moses. But with whom was He grieved 40 years? Wasn't it with them who sinned, whose carcasses fell in the wilderness? And to whom did He swear, (Israel) they will not enter into His rest, but to them that did not believe. So we see that they can't enter in because of unbelief.

Hebrews 4 Warning to Christians from Israel's Apostasy!

1-2 Let us therefore fear, lest a promise being left us of entering into His rest, any of you should seem to come short of it. For unto us (Christians!) was the Gospel preached, as well as to them (the Israelites): but the Word preached did not benefit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard it.


3-4 For we which have believed do enter into rest, as he said, 'I have sworn in My wrath, if they shall enter in My rest, although the works were finished before the foundation of the world.

5-6 For He spoke in a certain place of the 7th Day on this wise: And God did rest the 7th day from all His works. And in this place again, if they shall enter into My rest. Seeing therefore it remains that some must enter therein, and they to whom it was first preached did not enter in because of unbelief.

7-10. Again He limited a certain day, saying in David, Today after so long a time; as it is written said, Today, if you will not harden your heart. For if Jesus had given them rest, then He would not have spoken of another day. There remains therefore a rest to the people of God. For he that is entered into his rest, has also ceased from his own works, as God did also from His.

11. Let us labor therefore to enter into His rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief (apostasy).

The Day of Rest - The 7th Day - The Millennial Kingdom of Christ!



What about Cain? Genesis 4

Eve gave birth to Cain after the fall (“possessed”), then Abel (probably twins) (1-2)

Cain is a farmer, Abel is a shepherd

Both sons understand giving sacrifices to God for sin, Both recognize God (3)

Cain brought the fruit of the ground, (not firstfruits) and is rejected (3-5)

While Abel brought the best, first of the flock (a blood sacrifice) and is accepted

God tries to reason with Cain in his rage

“Sin (satan) is at the door, and his desire is to have you. You can defeat him”

Cain kills innocent Abel and lies to God

Abel's blood cries out to God

Cain is cursed from the earth, he now has to hide from God and wander as a vagabond.

He settles in Nod. The generations of Cain given are also 7! His descendants are responsible for introducing: polygamy, musical instruments, weapons of war, wanderers in tents, and murder.

The Way of Cain

- Joshua 15:57 “the cities of Cain, the Kenites his descendants (Chuck Missler)
- Hebrews 11:4 – “By faith, Abel offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which Abel obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying to his gifts: and by it, he being dead yet speaks.
- 1 John 3:12 “Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous.”
- Jude 11 “Woe unto them! For they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Korah.”

What about Balaam? Numbers 22-24

Num.23:1-4,11,16, 25-30; Num. 24:1-3, 10, 12, 15, 25; Num. 31:8,16; Deut 23:4-5

Josh. 13:22; 24:9-10; Neh. 13:2; Micah 6:5; 2 Peter 2:15; Jude 11; Rev.2:14

Balaam, (“devourer”)son of Beor from Pethor is asked by King of Moab ,Balak, (son of Zippor) to curse the Israelites Israel is (camped on Jericho side of Jordan River) .

Moab was terrified of the Israelites coming to promised Land & the Power of their God.

Moab and Midian offered money from divination for Balaam's prophetic gifts.

God spoke to Balaam and told him NOT to go with them to curse Israel.

God declared Israel blessed. So at first Balaam obediently refused them. *Token obedience*

King Balak sent higher nobles with more \$\$ & promised Balaam great promotion

Balaam said he could not go against God for all their silver and gold,

but added Wait, I will ask God again.. so God said go with them.. *man's sovereign choice to sin*

But God's anger was hot against Balaam. Balaam's donkey refused to proceed because he could see into the spirit realm.

The Angel of the Lord was ready to kill Balaam. The donkey spoke after Balaam threatened to kill the donkey.

God said Balaam had a perverse way. Balaam repented. *Lipservice not change of heart*

Balak offered a sacrifice at Kirjath-Huzoth on top of a high Mt.

Then he built 7 altars & prepared 7 sacrifices and God met Balaam and gave him this word:

“Balak, king of Moab brought me from Aram out of the Mountains of the east, saying ‘Come, curse Jacob, Defy Israel.’

How shall I curse the one God has not cursed: How shall I defy one whom God has not defied?

“From the top of the rocks I see Him & from the top of the hills I behold Him: lo, the people shall dwell alone, and shall not be reckoned among the nations . Who can count the dust of Jacob, and the number of ¼ part of Israel? Let me die the death of the righteous, and my last end shall be like Jacob”

Instead The Holy Spirit causes Balaam to prophesy God's Blessing of Israel!

Balak is furious that Balaam prophesies blessing for Israel instead of cursing.

So he takes him to another Mt., builds 7 more altars & the Lord give Balaam another prophecy... "Rise up Balak, & hear; hearken to me, son of Zippor. God is not a man that he should lie, neither the son of man that he should repent. Has he said and will not He do it? Has He spoken and will not He make it good? Behold I have received commandment to bless: He has blessed, and I can't reverse it."

"God has not held iniquity in Jacob, neither has He seen perverseness in Israel. The Lord God is with him, and the shout of a King is among them. God brought them out of Egypt: he has as it were the strength of a unicorn. Surely there is NO enchantment against Jacob, neither is there an divination against Israel: according to this time it shall be said of Israel and Jacob, What has God done ! "

And Balak tried it a 3rd time on a new mt. top.

Now Balaam has an open trance and prophesies "How goodly are your tents, O Jacob, and your tabernacles, O Israel. As the valleys they are spread forth, as gardens by the rivers' side, as trees that the Lord has planted, as cedars beside the waters. He shall pour waters out of His buckets, and His seed shall be in many waters, and His King shall be higher than Agag (Gog) and His Kingdom shall be exalted. God brought Jacob forth out of Egypt. He has the strength of a unicorn: he shall eat up the nations his enemies, and shall break their bones, and pierce them thru with His arrows. He crouched, he lay down a lion, and a great lion: who shall stir him up? Blessed is he that blesses you (Israel) & cursed is he that curses you."

More anger from King Balak and Balaam delivers a final prophecy:

"I shall see Him, but not now, I shall behold Him, but not nigh:

There shall come a Star out of Jacob, and a Scepter shall rise out of Israel, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth. And Edom shall be a possession, Seir also a possession for his enemies, and Israel shall be valiantly. Out of Jacob shall come He that shall have dominion, and shall destroy him that remains of the city. And about Amalek (grandson of Esau): Amalek was the 1st of nations: but his latter end shall be that he perish forever. And the Kenites, "Strong is your dwellingplace, and you put your nest in a rock, Nevertheless, the Kenite shall be wasted, until Ashur carry you away captive." "Alas who shall live when God does this? "And ships shall come from the coast of Chittim, & shall afflict Asshur, and shall afflict Eber, & he also shall forever."

Num 25 Moabite women seduce Israeli men/ 24,000 die of plague/ righteous Phinehas stops the plague with a spear!

Num 31:8 "They slew the kings of Midian, beside the rest of them that were slain; namely Evi, Rekem, Zur, Hur, Reba (The 5 Midian Kings); also **Balaam**, the son of Beor they slew with the sword.

Number 31:15-16 "Have you saved all the women alive?" asked Moses. "Behold, these caused the children of Israel, **through Balaam's counsel**, to commit trespass against the Lord in the matter of Beor, and there was a plague among the congregation of the Lord."

Deut. 23:3-6 "An Ammonite or a Moabite shall not enter into the Congregation of the Lord; even to the 10th generation shall they not enter into the congregation of the Lord forever. Because they met you not with water and bread in the way, when you came forth out of Egypt; and because **they hired Balaam**, the son of Peor of Pethor of Mesopotamia, **to curse you**. Nevertheless the Lord your God would not hearken to Balaam; but the Lord your God turned the curse into a blessing to you, because the Lord loved you! You shall NOT seek their peace of their prosperity all your days forever."

Joshua 13:21-22 "And all the cities of the plain, and all the kingdom of Sihon King of the Amorites, which reigned in heshbon, whom Moses killed with the princes of Midian: Evi, Rekem, Zur, Hur and Reba, which were dukes of Sihon, dwelling in the country. **Balaam** also, the son of Peor, **the soothsayer**, did the children of Israel kill with the sword among them that were slain."

Joshua 24:9-10 "then Balak, son of Zippor, King of Moab, rose and warred against Israel, and send and called Balaam, the son of Beor, to curse you. But I would not hearken to Balaam; therefore he blessed you still; so I delivered you out of his hand."

Nehemiah 13:1-2 "On that day they read in the Book of Moses in the audience of the people; and therein was found written, that the Ammonite & the Moabite should not come into the congregation of the Lord forever. Because they met not the children of Israel with bread and with water, but **hired Balaam against them, that he should curse them**: howbeit our God turned the curse into a blessing."

Micah 6:5 "O My people, remember now what Balak, King of Moab consulted, and what **Balaam**, son of Beor answered him from Shittim unto Gilgal; that you may know the righteousness of the Lord."

Peter 2:15 "Which have forsaken the right way, and are gone astray, following the **way of Balaam**, the son of Bosor, who loved the wages of unrighteousness, but was rebuked for his iniquity: the dumb ass speaking with man's voice forbad **the madness of the prophet**."

Jude 11 "Woe to them, for they have gone the way of Cain, and **ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward**, and perished in the gainsaying of Korah."

Rev. 2:14 (To the Church of Pergamos) " But I have a few things against you, because you have there them that hold the **doctrine of Balaam**, who taught Balak to cast a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols and to commit fornication . "



Now **Korah** (son of Izhar, sons of Kohath, son of Levi) and Dathan and Abiram (sons of Eliab) and On, (son of Peleth, sons of Rueben) took men & they rose up against Moses, with certain of the children of Israel, 250 princes of the assembly, famous in the congregation, men of renown. They said to Moses and Aaron, "you take too much on you, seeing all the congregation are holy, every one, and the Lord is among them: why left yourselves up above the congregation?" *Rebellion, Pride*

Moses heard and fell on his face, then said to **Korah**.. "Tomorrow the Lord will show who are His, and who is holy and will cause him to come near to Him, even him whom God has chosen will He cause to come near. Take your censers, **Korah & all your company**, and put fire in there, and put incense in them before the Lord tomorrow. The man whom the Lord shall choose shall be holy, **you take too much on you, sons of Levi**. Do you think it is a small thing to **you**, that God has separated you from the congregation of Israel, to bring you near to Himself to do the Tabernacle service and to stand before the congregation to minister to them? **Do you seek the priesthood** too? *Arrogant Ambition - Planning Leadership Takeover*

For this cause **you and all your company** are gathered together against the Lord: and why are **you murmuring** against Aaron?

Moses called Dathan and Abiram: they said, 'we will not come up. Is it a small thing that you have brought us up out of a land that flows with milk and honey, to kill us in the wilderness, except you also make yourself a prince over us? Moreover, you have not brought us to a land of mild and honey, or given us the inheritance of fields and vineyards; will you put out the eyes of these men? We will not come up'

Moses was very angry, & said to the Lord, 'Respect not their offerings; I have not taken one ass from them, neither have I hurt one of them.'

So Moses told them (all 250) to come with censers and incense tomorrow and they came up.

God said to Moses, 'Separate yourselves from this congregation, that I may consume them.'
And they fell on their faces and said, God will you be angry with the whole congregation if 1 man sins?

So Moses told everyone to separate from the tents of **Korah**, Dathan, and Abiram. Those men and their entire families came out. Moses asked the Lord to do a new thing and open up the earth and swallow them up, with all that they had, so that they would go down into the pit; then they will understand they have provoked the Lord. *"Provoking the Lord"*

A great earthquake immediately broke open the earth and swallowed them alive; their houses, and all their goods. All Israel fled at their cries, and God sent a fire & consumed also the 250 princes that offered incense. Then Eleazar the priest took their censers and made flat plates for the altar as a sign to the children of Israel, as a memorial, so that no Israeli or stranger who is not of Aaron's see will come near to offer incense. Yet, the people complained about these deaths and God sent a plague 14,700 died before Moses directed Aaron to place incense on the altar and make atonement to stop the plague.

Num. 26:9-11; Tribe of Reuben, son Pallu, son Eliab, sons Nemuel, Dathan & Abiram, who are famous because they strove against Moses and Aaron **in the company of Korah**, when they strove against God. And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up together with **Korah**, when that company died, then the fire devoured 250 men: they became a sign. Notwithstanding the children of **Korah** died not. *God didn't punish Korah's innocent sons!*

Num. 27:3 "Our father died in the wilderness, & he was not in **Korah's company**, but died in his own sins, & had no sons."

Korah's Sons Live to Serve the LORD (Check out the Psalms!)

1 Chron. 6:37 "the son of Tahath, the son of Assir, the son of Ebiasaph, the son of Korah, the son of Izhar, the son of Kohath, the son of Levi, he son of Israel."

1 Chron. 9:19 "And Shallum, the son of Kore, the son of Ebiasaph, the son of Korah, and his brethren, of the house of his father, the Kohathites, were over the world of the service, keepers of the gates of the Tabernacle: and their fathers, being over the host of the Lord, were keepers of the entry.


