God's Wrath Poured Out
Mystery Babylon Judged
King Jesus Comes to Conquer



Revelation 15 “The 7 Bowls of Wrath”

1. And I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, 7 angels having the 7 last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.
2. And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and them that had gotten the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.
3. And they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are thy ways, You King of saints.
4. Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You only are holy: for all nations shall come and worship before You; for Your judgments are made manifest.
5. And after that I looked, and, behold, the Temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:
6. And the 7 angels came out of the temple, having the 7 plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles.
7. And one of the 4 beasts gave unto the seven angels 7 golden vials full of the wrath of God, who lives forever and ever.
8. And the Temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from His power; and no man was able to enter into the Temple, till the 7 plagues of the 7 angels were fulfilled.

Revelation 16 = The Bowls of Wrath Poured Out”

1. And I heard a great voice out of the Temple saying to the 7 angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth.
2. And the 1st went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image.
3. And the 2nd angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea.

4. And the 3rd angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of waters;
and they became blood.
5. And I heard the angel of the waters say, You are righteous, O Lord, who is,
and was, and shall be, because You hast judged thus.
- 6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets,
and You hast given them blood to drink; for they are worthy.
7. And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty,
true and righteous are Your judgments.
8. And the 4th angel poured out his vial upon the sun;
and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire.
9. And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the Name of God,
which has power over these plagues: and they repented not to give Him glory.
10. And the 5th angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast;
and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain,
11. And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores,
and repented not of their deeds.
12. And the 6th angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water
thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.
13. And I saw 3 unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon,
and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.
14. For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles,
which go forth to the kings of the earth and of the whole world,
to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.
15. Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watches, and keeps his garments,
lest he walk naked, and they see his shame.
16. And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon.
17. And the 7th angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the
Temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done.

18. And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.
- 19 And the great city was divided into 3 parts, and the cities of the nations fell:
and great Babylon came in remembrance before God,
to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath.
- 20 And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.
21. And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail;
for the plague thereof was exceeding great.

Revelation 17 "Mystery Babylon Revealed"

1. And there came one of the 7 angels which had the 7 vials, and talked with me,
saying to me, Come hither; I will show unto you the judgment of the great whore
that sits upon many waters:
2. With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants
of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.
3. So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit on
a scarlet colored beast, full of names of blasphemy, having 7 heads and 10 horns.
4. And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet color, and decked with gold and precious
stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations
and filthiness of her fornication:
5. And on her forehead was a name written, Mystery, Babylon The Great,
the Mother Of Harlots And Abominations Of The Earth.
6. And I saw the woman drunk with the blood of the saints, and with the blood
of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great horror.
7. And the angel said to me, Wherefore do you marvel? I will tell you the mystery of the
woman, and of the beast that carries her, which has the 7 heads and 10 horns.
8. The beast that you saw was, and is not; and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit,
and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the earth shall wonder,
whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world,
when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

9. And here is the mind which has wisdom.
The 7 heads are 7 mountains, on which the woman sits.
10. And there are 7 kings: 5 are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come;
and when he cometh, he must continue a short space.
11. And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the 8th, and is of the 7,
and goes into perdition
12. And the 10 horns which you saw are 10 kings, which have received no kingdom as yet;
but receive power as kings one hour with the beast.
13. These have one mind, and shall give their power and strength to the beast.
14. These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of
lords, and King of kings: and they that are with Him are called, and chosen, and faithful.
15. And he said to me, The waters which you saw, where the whore sits,
are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.
16. And the 10 horns which you saw on the beast, these shall hate the whore,
and shall make her desolate and naked, and shall eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.
17. For God has put in their hearts to fulfill His will, and to agree,
and give their kingdom unto the beast, until the words of God shall be fulfilled.
19. And the woman which you saw is that great city, which reigns over the kings of the earth.

Revelation 18 - "Mystery Babylon Judged"

1. And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power;
and the earth was lightened with his glory.
2. And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is
become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every
unclean and hateful bird.
3. For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication,
and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her,
and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

4. And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, My people,
that you be not partakers of her sins, and that you receive not of her plagues.
5. For her sins have reached unto heaven, and God hath remembered her iniquities.
6. Reward her even as she rewarded you, and double unto her double according to her works:
in the cup which she hath filled fill to her double.
7. How much she has glorified herself, and lived deliciously, so much torment and sorrow give
her: for she says in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.
8. Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine;
and she shall be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judges her.
9. And the kings of the earth, who have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her,
shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning,
10. Standing afar off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that great city Babylon,
that mighty city! For in one hour is your judgment come.
11. And the merchants of the earth shall weep and mourn over her;
for no man buys their merchandise any more:
12. The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen,
and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all thyine wood, and all manner vessels of ivory, and all
manner vessels of most precious wood, and of brass, and iron, and marble,
13. And cinnamon, and odors, and ointments, and frankincense, and wine, and oil, and fine
flour, and wheat and beasts and sheep and horses and chariots and slaves and souls of men.
14. And the fruits that thy soul lusted after are departed from you,
and all things which were dainty and goodly are departed from you,
and you shalt find them no more at all.
15. The merchants of these things, which were made rich by her,
shall stand afar off for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing,
16. And saying, Alas, alas that great city, that was clothed in fine linen, and purple,
and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls.

17. For in one hour so great riches is come to nought. And every shipmaster,
and all the company in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood afar off,
18. And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying,
What city is like unto this great city!
19. And they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying,
Alas, alas that great city,
wherein were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her costliness!
For in one hour is she made desolate.
20. Rejoice over her, you heaven, and you holy apostles and prophets;
for God has avenged you on her.
20. And a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying,
Thus with violence shall that great city Babylon be thrown down,
and shall be found no more at all.
22. And the voice of harpers, and musicians, and of pipers, and trumpeters,
shall be heard no more at all in you;
and no craftsman, of whatsoever craft he be, shall be found any more in you;
and the sound of a millstone shall be heard no more at all in you;
23. And the light of a candle shall shine no more at all in you;
and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride shall be heard no more at all in you:
for your merchants were the great men of the earth;
for by your sorceries were all nations deceived.
24. And in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints,
and of all that were slain upon the earth.

Revelation 19 ‘The Halleluia’s’ “The King is Coming”

1. And after these things I heard a great voice of much people in heaven, saying, Halleluia;
Salvation, and glory, and honor, and power, unto the Lord our God:
2. For true and righteous are His judgments: for He has judged the great whore,
which did corrupt the earth with her fornication,
and has avenged the blood of His servants at her hand.
3. And again they said, Halleluia. And her smoke rose up forever and ever.

4. And the 24 elders and the 4 beasts fell down Halleluia.
- 5 And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all you His servants,
and you that fear Him, both small and great.
6. And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters,
as the voice of mighty thunderings, saying,
Alleluia: for the Lord God omnipotent reigns.
7. Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to Him:
for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His wife hath made herself ready.
8. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white:
for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints.
9. And he said to me, Write,
Blessed are they which are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb.
And he said to me, These are the true sayings of God.
10. And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said to me, See you do it not:
I am thy fellow servant, and of your brethren that have the testimony of Jesus:
Worship God: For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.
11. And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse;
and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True,
and in righteousness He does judge and make war.
12. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns;
and He had a name written, that no man knew, but He Himself.
13. And He was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: (Isaiah 63:1-6)
and His name is called The Word of God.
14. And the armies which were in heaven followed Him upon white horses,
clothed in fine linen, white and clean.
15. And out of his mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should smite the nations:
and He shall rule them with a rod of iron:
and He treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

16 And He has on his vesture and on His thigh a name written,
King Of Kings, and Lord Of Lords.

17. And I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice,
saying to all the fowls that fly in the midst of heaven,
Come and gather yourselves together unto the supper of the great God;

18. That you may eat the flesh of kings,
and the flesh of captains,
and the flesh of mighty men,
and the flesh of horses,
and of them that sit on them,
and the flesh of all men,
both free and bond, both small and great.

19. And I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies,
gathered together to make war against Him that sat on the horse, and against His army.

20. And the beast was taken,
and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him,
with which he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast,
and them that worshipped his image.
These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of him that sat upon the horse,
which sword proceeded out of his mouth:
and all the fowls were filled with their flesh
