¹ And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, [Rom 15:12](#) and a Branch (netzer) shall grow out of his roots: [The Branch- Jeremiah 23:5; 33:15; Zechariah 3:8; 6:12; "A Nazarene" Matthew 2:23](#)

² And the Spirit of the Lord shall rest upon Him, the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord; ["The 7 Spirits of God" - Rev 1:4; 3:1; 4:5; 5:6; "The 7 Eyes of the Lord" - Zechariah 3:9; 4:10](#) [Attributes of Holy Ghost](#)

³ And shall make Him of quick understanding in the fear of the Lord: and He shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears:

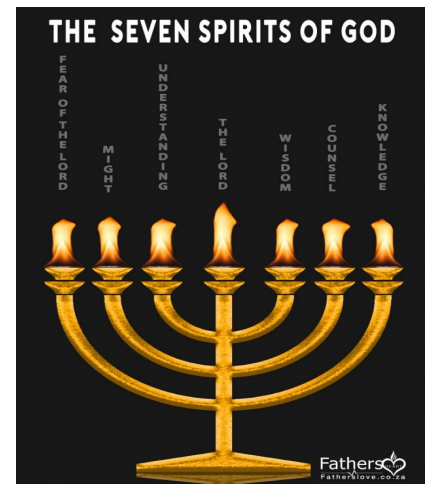

¹⁰ And *in that Day* there shall be a root of Jesse, [same as Rev 5:5; 22:16; "The root of David"](#) which shall stand for an ensign of the people; ["a standard" Isaiah 19:59; 13:12,18; 30:17; 31:9; 49:22; 62:10;](#) to it shall the Gentiles seek: and His rest shall be glorious. [The sign is the Messiah](#)

¹¹ And it shall come to pass *in that Day*, that the Lord shall set His hand again the 2nd time to recover the remnant of His people, which shall be left: from Assyria, and from Egypt, and from Pathros, and from Cush, and from Elam, and from Shinar, and from Hamath, and from the islands of the sea.



¹² And He shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the 4 corners of the earth. [Matt 24:31](#). [Mark 13:27](#); [Revelation 20:8](#) - idiom for End time re-gathering of Jews from the north, south, east, west - same as "from the 4 winds of Heaven" [Jeremiah 49:36](#); [Zechariah 2:6](#); [6:5](#); [Daniel 7:2](#); [Revelation 7:1](#) "Ensign for the nations" = Jesus He is the sign for the re-gathering of all Israel. An ensign / standard was always raised on a hill or mountain [Isa 18:3](#). When Moses raised the brazen serpent on a pole in [Numbers 21:8](#), "pole" is the same Hebrew word as "ensign" in [Isaiah 11:12](#). Those who looked on the serpent were healed, representing Jesus as Healer. [John 3:14-15](#)

¹³ The envy also of Ephraim (Northern Kingdom) shall depart, and the adversaries of Judah (Southern Kingdom) shall be cut off: Ephraim shall not envy Judah, and Judah shall not vex Ephraim.



¹⁴ But they shall fly upon the shoulders of the Philistines toward the west; they shall spoil them of the east together: they shall lay their hand upon Edom and Moab; and the children of Ammon shall obey them.



¹⁵ And the Lord shall utterly destroy the tongue of the Egyptian sea; and with His mighty wind shall He shake His hand over the river, and shall smite it in the 7 streams, and make men go over dry-shod.

¹⁶ And there shall be an highway for the remnant of His people, which shall be left, from Assyria; like as it was to Israel in the day that he came up out of the land of Egypt.

1. *The Spirit of the Lord*
2. *The Spirit of Wisdom*
3. *The Spirit of Understanding*
4. *The Spirit of Counsel*
5. *The Spirit of Might*
6. *The Spirit of Knowledge*
7. *The Spirit of the Fear of the Lord*

Isaiah Chapter 11 “The Messiah – The Branch”

Isaiah 11:1 “And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse and a Branch ([Hebrew “netzer”](#)) shall grow out of his roots.”

Here we find another wonderful name-tag for the Messiah. He is the Branch of the Lord! This is the very verse referred to in Matthew 2:23 that tells the world He will be a Nazarene.

Matthew 2 :23 “And he (Joseph) came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, He shall be called a Nazarene.”

John 1:45 “Phillip found Nathaniel and said to him, ‘We have found Him, of whom Moses, the Torah, and the prophets did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.’”

More Old Testament prophecies about The Branch – The Messiah:

Isaiah 4:2 “For in that Day shall *the branch of the Lord* be beautiful and glorious, and the fruit of the earth shall be excellent and comely for them that are escaped of the Lord.”

Jeremiah 23:5 “Behold, the days come, says the Lord, that I will raise unto David *a righteous Branch*, and a King that shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.”

Zechariah 3:8-9 “Hear now, O Joshua the High Priest, and your fellows that sit before you: for these are men wondered at: for behold, I will bring forth *My servant the Branch*. For behold the stone that I have laid before Joshua: upon 1 stone shall be 7 eyes, [7 eyes = 7 spirits](#) says the Lord of hosts, and I will remove the iniquity of that Land in one day.”

Zechariah 6:12-13 “And speak to him saying, ‘Thus speaks the Lord of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is *The Branch*; and He shall grow up out of His place, and He shall build the Temple of the Lord. Even He shall build the Temple of the Lord, and He shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon His throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.’”

Isaiah 53:2 “For He shall grow up before Him as *a tender plant, and as a root* out of dry ground: He has no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him.”

The Abominable Branch is the Anti-christ! Check out **Isaiah 14:19**

“With the Breath of His Mouth...”

Old Testament

Isaiah 11:4 “But with righteousness shall he judge the poor,
and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth:
and He shall smite the earth with the rod of His mouth,
and with the breath of His lips shall he slay the wicked.”

Isaiah 30:27 “Behold, the Name of the Lord comes from far; burning with His anger and the burden thereof is heavy: His lips are full of indignation and His tongue as a devouring fire.

28. And His breath as an overflowing stream, shall reach to the midst of the neck,
to sift the nations with the sieve of vanity:
and there shall be a bridle (a hook) in the jaws of the people, causing them to err.

29. You shall have a song, as in the night when a Holy solemnity is kept ([Yom Kippur](#))
and gladness of heart as when one goes with a pipe to come to the Mountain of the Lord
to the Mighty One of Israel ([The Feast of Tabernacles](#)).

30. And the Lord shall cause His glorious voice to be heard,
and shall show the lighting down of His Arm ([Messiah](#)) with the indignation of His anger,
and with a devouring fire, with scattering and tempest and hailstones.

31. For through the voice of the Lord shall the Assyrian be beaten down, which smote with a rod.

32. And in every place where the grounded staff shall pass, which the Lord shall lay upon him,
it shall be with tabrets and harps: and in battles of shaking will he fight with it.

“With the Breath of His Mouth”

In the New Testament

2 Thessalonians 2: 1-12

1. Now we beseech you brethren, by the Coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto Him
 2. That you be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the Day of Christ is at hand.
 3. Let no man deceive you by any means, for that Day shall not come, except there be a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition.
 4. and exalts himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped: so that he as God sits in the Temple of God, showing himself that he is God.
 5. Remember not, that when I was yet with you, I told you these things?
 6. And now you know that withholds that he might be revealed in his time.
 7. For the mystery of iniquity does already work:
only he who now lets will let, until he be taken out of the way.
 8. And then shall that wicked (lawless) one be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume *with the breath of His mouth*, and shall destroy by the brightness of His Coming.
 9. Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders.
 10. And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish:
because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.
 11. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie.
 12. That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
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Isaiah 11 - "Messiah is The Ensign - The Standard to the Nations"

God is declaring His Messiah Jesus as a sign to the nations. He is drawing His Chosen people back to the Land of Israel by His Spirit. This is the biggest sign of the End Times - the re-gathering of the Jews from the north, the south the east and the west. In Israel, a standard was lifted up on a hill to announce a call to arms, and a call to gather the tribes. The Messiah is coming to fight God's enemies. His righteous judgment is a standard and a sign to the nations.

Isaiah 59:19 " So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall lift up a standard against him.

Numbers 21:8 And the LORD said to Moses, Make a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole H5251 and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looks upon it, shall live.

Num 21:9 And Moses made a serpent of brass, and put it upon a pole, H5251 and it came to pass, that if a serpent had bitten any man, when he beheld the serpent of brass, he lived.

Numbers 26:10 And the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up together with Korah, when that company died, what time the fire devoured 250 men: and they became a sign. H5251

Psalms 60:4 You have given a banner H5251 to them that fear You, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah.

Isaiah 5:26 And He will lift up an ensign H5251 to the nations from far, and will hiss to them from the end of the earth: and, behold, they shall come with speed swiftly:

Isaiah 11:10 And in that day there shall be a root of Jesse, which shall stand for an ensign H5251 of the people; to it shall the Gentiles seek: and His rest shall be glorious.

Isaiah 11:12 And He shall set up an ensign H5251 for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the 4 corners of the earth.

Isaiah 13:2 Lift up a banner H5251 upon the high mountain, exalt the voice unto them, shake the hand, that they may go into the gates of the nobles.

Isaiah 18:3 All ye inhabitants of the world, and dwellers on the earth, see ye, when He lifts up an ensign H5251 on the mountains; and when He blows a trumpet, hear ye.

Isaiah 30:17 One thousand *shall flee* at the rebuke of one; at the rebuke of 5 shall ye flee: till ye be left as a beacon upon the top of a mountain, and as an ensign **H5251** on an hill.

Isaiah 31:9 And he shall pass over to his strong hold for fear, and his princes shall be afraid of the ensign, **H5251** says the LORD, whose fire *is* in Zion, and his furnace in Jerusalem.

Isa 33:23 Thy tacklings are loosed; they could not well strengthen their mast, they could not spread the sail: **H5251** then is the prey of a great spoil divided; the lame take the prey.

Isa 49:22 Thus says the Lord GOD, Behold, I will lift up My hand to the Gentiles, and set up My standard **H5251** to the people: and they shall bring your sons in *their* arms, and your daughters shall be carried upon *their* shoulders.

Isa 62:10 Go through, go through the gates; prepare ye the way of the people; cast up, cast up the highway; gather out the stones; lift up a standard **H5251** for the people.

Jeremiah 4:6 Set up the standard **H5251** toward Zion: retire, stay not: for I will bring evil from the north, and a great destruction.

Jeremiah 4:21 How long shall I see the standard, **H5251** and hear the sound of the trumpet?

Jeremiah 50:2 Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; **H5251** publish, and conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.

Jeremiah 51:12 Set up the standard **H5251** upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD has both devised and done that which He spoke against the inhabitants of Babylon.

Jeremiah 51:27 Set ye up a standard **H5251** in the land, blow the trumpet among the nations, prepare the nations against her, call together against her the kingdoms of Ararat, Minni, and Ashchenaz; appoint a captain against her; cause the horses to come up as the rough caterpillers. (locusts)

Isaiah Chapter 11:12 "4 Corners, 4 Winds, 4 Angels"

Wherever we find this combination of words in the Word of God, know they are an End Time marker for the Jews as God's Chosen people. They will be re-gathered from the 4 corners of the earth from where God scattered them because of their rebellion against Him and also because they refused Jesus as the Messiah. Hence the destruction of Jerusalem in 70 AD. So many Bible teachers have interpreted these key verses to apply to the Church in the tribulation, when Israel and the Jews are God's specific target for redemption at that time. Other key words that refer to the same group and same prophetic time: "from the north, the south, and east and the west" are another way of saying "from the 4 corners."

Isaiah 11:12 "And He shall set up an ensign for the nations, and shall assemble the outcasts of Israel, and gather together the dispersed of Judah from the 4 corners of the earth."

Matthew 24:30-31 " And then shall appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory. And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet and they shall gather His elect from the 4 winds, from one end of heaven to the other."

Mark 13:27 "And He shall send His angels and shall gather His elect from the 4 winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven"

Revelation 7:1 "And after these things I saw 4 angels standing on the 4 corners of the earth, holding the 4 winds of the earth, that the wind should not blow on the earth, nor on the sea, nor on any tree."

Revelation 20:7-8 "And when the 1,000 years are expired, satan shall be loosed out of his prison, and shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the 4 corners of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: for the number of them is as the sand of the sea."

Zechariah 2:6 " Ho, Ho, come forth, and flee from the land of the North, says the Lord: for I have spread you abroad as the 4 winds of heaven, says the Lord."

“I will Gather you from the North, the South, the East, and the West”

Isaiah 43:5-6 “Do not fear, for I am with you; I will bring your offspring from the east, and gather you from the west. “I will say to the north, ‘Give them up! ‘And to the south, ‘Do not hold them back.’ Bring My sons from afar and My daughters from the ends of the earth,”

Jeremiah 29:13-14 “And you shall seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all of your heart. And I will be found of you, says the Lord: and I will turn away your captivity, and I will gather you from all the nations and from all the places where I have driven you, says the Lord: and I will bring you again in to the place where I cause you to be carried away captive.”

Luke 13:29 “And they will come from east and west and from north and south, and will recline at the table in the kingdom of God.

Psalms 107:3 “And gathered them out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south.”

Jeremiah 16:14-15 “Therefore behold, days are coming,” declares the LORD, “when it will no longer be said, ‘As the LORD lives, who brought up the sons of Israel out of the land of Egypt,’ but, ‘As the LORD lives, who brought up the sons of Israel from the land of the north and from all the countries where He had banished them.’ For I will restore them to their own land which I gave to their fathers.

Jeremiah 23:8 “But, The Lord lives, which brought up and which led the seed of the house of Israel out of the north country, and from all countries whither I had driven them; and they shall dwell in their own land.”

Deuteronomy 30:1-5 “And it shall come to pass, when all these things are come upon you, the blessing and the curse, which I have set before you, and you shalt call them to mind among all the nations, whither the Lord thy God hath driven you, And shalt return unto the Lord your God, and shalt obey His voice according to all that I command you this day, you and your children, with all your heart, and with all your soul; That then the Lord thy God will turn your captivity, and have compassion upon you, and will return and **gather you from all the nations,** whither the Lord your God hath scattered you.

“If any of you be driven out unto the **outmost parts of heaven,** from thence will the Lord your God gather you, and from thence will He fetch you: And the Lord your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shalt possess it; and He will do you good, and multiply you above your fathers.”

Made Possible By Salvation in Jesus

The Holy Spirit Living inside Us
Activates Spiritual Gifts
And Causes the Overflow of the Spirit
When God uses us supernaturally to touch others!

In the Old Testament the Holy Spirit rested on, and came upon people,
but until the new birth could not indwell people.
That changed once Jesus rose from the dead.

John 16:12 Jesus to His disciples “I have yet many things to say to you,
but you cannot bear them now.”

Why? Because they did not yet have the Holy Spirit living inside them yet.

John 16:13, Jesus says, “Howbeit when He, the Spirit of truth, is come,
He will guide you into all truth: for He shall not speak of Himself;
but whatsoever He shall hear, that shall He speak:
and He will show you things to come.”

John 14:26, “But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost,
Whom the Father will send in My name,
He shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your
remembrance, whatsoever I have spoken to you.”

1 Cor. 2:14 “the natural man receives not the things of the Spirit of God:
for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them,

Proverbs Chapter 8

- ¹ Does not **wisdom** cry? And does not understanding put forth her voice?
- ² **She** stands in the top of high places, by the way in the places of the paths.
- ³ She cries at the gates, at the entry of the city, at the coming in at the doors.
- ⁴ Unto you, O men, **I call**; and **My voice** is to the sons of man.
- ⁵ O you simple, understand **wisdom**: and, you fools, be of an understanding heart.
- ⁶ Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of My lips shall be right things.
- ⁷ For My mouth shall speak truth; and wickedness is an abomination to My lips.

- ²¹ That I may cause those that **love Me** to inherit substance; and **I will fill** their treasures.

"The Holy Spirit is Called Wisdom in the Old Testament"

²² The Lord possessed Me in the beginning of his way, before His works of old.

²³ I was set up from everlasting, from the beginning, or ever the earth was.

²⁴ When there were no depths, I was brought forth;
when there were no fountains abounding with water.

²⁵ Before the mountains were settled, before the hills was I brought forth:

²⁶ While as yet He had not made the earth, nor the fields,
nor the highest part of the dust of the world.

²⁷ When He prepared the heavens, I was there:
when He set a compass upon the face of the depth:

²⁸ When He established the clouds above:
when He strengthened the fountains of the deep:

²⁹ When He gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass His commandment:
when He appointed the foundations of the earth:

³⁰ Then I was by him, as one brought up with him:
and I was daily his delight, rejoicing always before him;

³¹ Rejoicing in the habitable part of His earth; and My delights were with the sons of men.

³² Now therefore hearken unto Me, O ye children: for blessed are they that keep My ways.

³³ Hear instruction, and be wise, and refuse it not.

³⁴ Blessed is the man that hears Me,
watching daily at My gates, waiting at the posts of My doors.

³⁵ For whoso finds Me finds life, and shall obtain favor of the Lord.

³⁶ But he that sins against Me wrongs his own soul: all they that hate Me love death.

“God’s Wisdom & The Holy Spirit”

An Amazing discovery for us is discerning who WISDOM is in the Old Testament. In Proverbs wisdom is a Person. In Exodus WISDOM is directly connected to The Holy Spirit. The Word of God is supernatural: its riches are for us to discover. The Holy Spirit comes alongside ordinary people to accomplish extraordinary things for the Plan of God! Amazing that The Holy Spirit, the very one who lives inside of you, can quicken us for every extraordinary act.

In Exodus In the Old Testament, The Holy Spirit came upon God’s Covenant people, the Jews, to give them supernatural wisdom to design/create things they have never seen before. According to Heaven’s pattern given by God to Moses, all the Holy garments, vessels, and furniture for the Temple are created exactly as God decreed - even though the people have never done anything like this before. Wisdom beyond their education, beyond their experience, beyond their natural understanding. God filled ordinary men and women with the Holy Spirit for a limited time to complete the work.

Exo 28:3 And thou shalt speak unto all *that are wise hearted*, whom I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto Me in the priest's office.

Exo 31:3 (God called Bezaleel) And I have filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, and in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,

Exo 31:6 And I, behold, I have given with him Aholiab, the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan: and in the hearts of all that are wise hearted I have put wisdom, that they may make all that I have commanded thee;

Exo 35:26 And all the women whose heart stirred them up in wisdom spun goats' *hair*.

Exo 35:31 And He has filled him with the spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, and in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship;

Exo 35:35 Them has He filled with wisdom of heart, to work all manner of work, of the engraver, and of the cunning workman, and of the embroiderer, in blue, and in purple, in scarlet, and in fine linen, and of the weaver, *even of them that do any work, and of those that devise cunning work*.

Exo 36:1 Then wrought Bezaleel and Aholiab, and every wise hearted man, in whom the LORD put wisdom and understanding to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD commanded.

Holy Ghost Wisdom is for God's Covenant People

And for Amazing Acts of Bravery, God gave WISDOM - The Holy Spirit - to ordinary people who are in Covenant with Him! READ on about Joshua, David, a woman in Beth Maachah, David, Solomon, Job, Daniel, Ezra and many more of God's Chosen people.

Deut 34:9 And Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom; for Moses had laid his hands upon him: and the children of Israel hearkened unto him, and did as the LORD commanded Moses.

2Sam 14:20 To fetch about this form of speech has thy servant Joab done this thing: and my lord *is* wise, according to the wisdom of an angel of God, to know all *things that are* in the earth.

2Sam 20:22 Then the woman went unto all the people in her wisdom. And they cut off the head of Sheba the son of Bichri, and cast *it* out to Joab. And he blew a trumpet, and they retired from the city, every man to his tent. And Joab returned to Jerusalem unto the king. (She prophesied the death of Sheba by revelation of the Spirit of God)

1Ki 4:29 And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that *is* on the seashore.

1Ki 4:30 And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt.

1Ki 4:34 And there came of all people to hear the wisdom of Solomon, from all kings of the earth, which had heard of his wisdom.

1 Kin 5:12 And the LORD gave Solomon wisdom, as he promised him: and there was peace between Hiram and Solomon; and they two made a league together.

God showed Daniel supernatural dreams and visions; He gave him wisdom and understanding of the End Times. Holy Spirit Wisdom!

Dan 1:17 As for these four children, God gave them knowledge and skill in Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams.

Dan 1:20 And in all matters of wisdom *and* understanding, that the king enquired of them, he found them ten times better than all the magicians *and* astrologers that *were* in all his realm

Dan 2:21 And He changes the times and the seasons: He removes kings, and sets up kings: He gives wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:

“God’s Wisdom & The Holy Spirit vs. Man’s Wisdom”

In the End Times, we must contend for the Presence of God in our homes and churches, our conversation and prayers. All else is vanity and foolishness – man’s wisdom.

The Holy Spirit reveals the Word to us. He reveals God’s secrets as we pray. He gives His wisdom to us before we speak. He is our spiritual discernment! He helps us worship the Father and testify about Jesus! He is the revealer of Truth.

“But Wisdom is Justified of all her children” Matthew 11:19 & Luke 7:35

Jesus is ministering now to an increasingly disbelieving crowd. He has one message for the curious crowd, but for those who press in closer and are hungry for spiritual truths, he begins to teach and explain parables. He says, “To whom will I liken this generation... like children sitting in a marketplace, who will neither mourn or repent, who accuse John the Baptist of having a devil, and accuse Him of being a winebibber and friend of sinners. They completely and willingly miss His message. But the Holy Spirit is wooing a smaller group at the same time. When Jesus says, “But Wisdom is justified of all her children,” He is declaring that the Holy Spirit can draw all those who want truth and separating them out of the curious crowd who only want to see signs and wonders, or who only want to argue and debate.

And So it is TODAY! By the Holy Spirit, people are being wooed and sifted – all at the same time. We can see everywhere people today who are willingly IGNORANT of TRUTH, and unless God’s Presence touches them, they will refuse to spiritually discern the battle over good and evil in the End Times.

Now when we read of God’s wisdom in the New Testament, prepare to get revelation truth!

Matt 13:54 “And when He (Jesus) came into his own country, He taught them in their synagogue, insomuch that they were astonished, and said “Whence has this man this wisdom, these mighty works?”

Mark 6:2 “And when the Sabbath day was come, He began to teach in the synagogue: many hearing Him were astonished, saying ‘From whence has this man these things? What wisdom is this which is given to Him, even such mighty miracles are wrought by His hands?’”

1 Corinthians 1:17-19 (Paul) “For Christ sent me not to baptize, but to preach the gospel: not with the wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ be made of no effect. For the preaching of the cross to them who perish is foolishness; but to us which are saved it is the power of God. For it is written, “I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent.”

1 Cor. 1:20- “Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?”

Go Ahead and Finish 1 Corinthians Chapter 1 and then read Chapter 2.

Paul is defending his style of preaching by the power of the Holy Ghost and contrasting God's wisdom by the Holy Spirit with the wisdom of this world – man's wisdom. Only by the Holy Spirit can we discern the wisdom of God. The Wisdom of God is directly tied to the Holy Spirit!

Now in Ephesians Wisdom and the Holy Spirit are connected again!

Eph. 1:8 "Wherein He has abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence (understanding.)

Eph 1:17 "That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him."

Eph 3:10 "to the intent that now unto the principalities and powers in heavenly places might be known by the Church the manifold wisdom of God."

— And Wisdom by the Holy Spirit is found in all 4 chapters of Colossians!

Col 1:9 For this cause we also, since the day we heard *it*, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding;

Col 1:28 Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus:

Col 2:3 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.

Col 2:23 Which things have indeed a show of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body; not in any honor to the satisfying of the flesh.

Col 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Col 4:5 Walk in wisdom toward them that are without, redeeming the time.

James has amazing verses on GOD'S WISDOM

James 1:5 If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that gives to all men liberally, and upbraids not; and it shall be given him.

Jas 3:13 Who is a wise man and endued with knowledge among you? Let him show out of a good conversation his works with meekness of wisdom.

Jm3 :15 This wisdom descends not from above, but is earthly, sensual, devilish.

Jas 3:17 But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, and to be entreated, full of mercy & good fruits, without partiality, Without hypocrisy.

Ruach Ha Kodesh Hebrew חַוֵּר שְׂדוּקָה = Divine Inspiration– Holy Spirit

Genesis 3: There were 2 trees in the garden– tree of the knowledge of good and evil – tree of life. Man lost his flow of divine wisdom through disobedience. Throughout the OT we see God imparting His wisdom on certain men for specific times and things, but only for a specified time. After He sent His Son to pay the price for the sin of the world He gives back the ability to access the **Ruach ha Kodesh**, or divine wisdom, back to man as he diligently seeks it and live a life worthy of flowing in it through the Holy Spirit – The Holy Spirit came inside of us to live.

Acts 1:8 “You shall receive power after the Holy Spirit”

(Acts 6:1-8) “And in those days, when the number of the disciples was multiplied, there arose a murmuring of the Grecians against the Hebrews, because their widows were neglected in the daily ministrations. {2} Then the twelve called the multitude of the disciples unto them, and said, It is not reason that we should leave the word of God, and serve tables. {3} Wherefore, brethren, look ye out among you seven men of honest report, full of the Holy Ghost and wisdom, whom we may appoint over this business. {4} But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word. {5} And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch: {6} Whom they set before the apostles: and when they had prayed, they laid their hands on them. {7} And the word of God increased; and the number of the disciples multiplied in Jerusalem greatly; and a great company of the priests were obedient to the faith. {8} And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.”

The selection of 7 deacons represents another aspect of the ministry of the Holy Spirit. That is, the ability to bring order out of confusion. This reflects wisdom, or the ability to solve problems. Like when God said let there be. (Genesis 1) Let's look at this spiritual wisdom in the scriptures. -- Of course we see this prophesied to be in Jesus.

(Isa 11:1-2) **And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots: {2} And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;**

You see, He knows the past, present, and future. He knows the mind of God in every situation. The 1st Adam knew and the 2nd Adam knows. He knows the calling of God on every individual. He knows everything about the financial world and the political world. Because He is the **Ruach Ha Kodesh**. ---- And we have the mind of Christ.

The Holy Spirit gave wisdom to Joseph about how to prepare for the future. ---

[\(Gen 41:38-40\)](#) And Pharaoh said unto his servants, Can we find such a one as this is, a man in whom the Spirit of God is? {39} And Pharaoh said unto Joseph, Forasmuch as God hath showed thee all this, there is none so discreet and wise as thou art: {40} Thou shalt be over my house, and according unto thy word shall all my people be ruled: only in the throne will I be greater than thou.”

He gave Daniel wisdom about the future of Babylon:

[\(Dan 5:11-12\)](#) “There is a man in thy kingdom, in whom is the spirit of the holy gods; and in the days of thy father light and understanding and wisdom, like the wisdom of the gods, was found in him; whom the king Nebuchadnezzar thy father, the king, I say, thy father, made master of the magicians, astrologers, Chaldeans, and soothsayers; {12} Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and knowledge, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and showing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar: now let Daniel be called, and he will show the interpretation.”

The Holy Spirit gave both these men a word of wisdom that brought promotion and favor in their nations. Wisdom is always a revelation of the pattern of God for a certain area of the kingdom. Every house has a blueprint, a pattern from which it is built. The Holy Spirit’s wisdom is evidenced when He shows you the pattern for anything you are trying to “build” – your life, family, finances, ministry, church, or nation.

It was through the Holy Spirit’s wisdom that Moses received the pattern for the Tabernacle.

[\(Exodus 25:9\)](#) “According to all that I show thee, after the pattern of the tabernacle, and the pattern of all the instruments thereof, even so shall ye make it.”

David received the pattern for the Holy Temple by the Spirit of Wisdom.

[\(1 Chr.28:12\)](#) “And the pattern of all that he had by the spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, and of all the chambers round about, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries of the dedicated things: “

Noah received the pattern for the ark, and Moses received the order for the march in the wilderness from this divine assignment that is given to man called the Spirit of Wisdom.

The Bible you hold in your hand is God’s Wisdom written for mankind.

[2 Tim 3:16](#) “All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: [17](#) That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works.”

Back to Acts 6 and let's look at the pattern for the church --- The fast growing church at Jerusalem was no longer able to keep up with the needs of the people. Their systems and structure had broken down. They needed a new pattern, a paradigm shift that would enable them to hold the growth. The solution was given to the twelve apostles. They yielded to the Holy Spirit's government in the church. He gave them the solution of appointing seven deacons to handle the feeding of the widows. The Twelve laid hands on the new deacons and delegated their authority to them. These elder and deacons were a carryover from the Old Testament priest and Levites. ALL of our problems arise from something being out of order! And if we will return to the "pattern," things will become simple and enjoyable again. --- somebody say amen!

Let's bring this down to where the rubber meets the road. --- How to walk in the wisdom of the Spirit. The Ruach Ha Kodesh.

1. Wisdom in your personal life --- (Eph 5:15-20) See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, {16} Redeeming the time, because the days are evil. {17} Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is. {18} And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; {19} Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; {20} Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

First, the Holy Spirit wants to give you wisdom in your personal life -- in your conduct, character, speech, habits, and decisions. If your filled with the Spirit at all times, then your won't act like a fool. In your personal life, you need wisdom in dealing with your time and your money. The Holy Spirit will help you prioritize your spending of time and use of money so that you can achieve the purpose to which you are called. You will give of yourself and your money as He leads you to and not as your self-centered natural man wants to do. You will flow out of the wisdom of God a always be successful as God has designed you to be.

2. Wisdom in your family life --- (Eph 5:21-25) Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God. {22} Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord. {23} For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body. {24} Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. {25} Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

Many families need to rediscover the pattern in the roles for husbands and wives. As head of the household, the man was intended to carry the physical, emotional, financial, and spiritual load. The wife was meant to be protected and loved so that she could flourish in her gifts and callings. Children are to be taught the pattern of respecting their parents, and parents are meant to be "Gods model of wisdom" for their children. This not only establishes the fear of God in their lives, but also imparts a sense of security in God's love.

When we get away from God's pattern for the family, -- foolishness, rebellion and chaos are the result. --- The society we live in today in America, is a statement to the foolishness of trying to build a family on the pattern of secular humanism.

3. Wisdom in your occupation --- (Eph 6:5-7) Servants, be obedient to them that are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in singleness of your heart, as unto Christ; {6} Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart; {7} With good will doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men:

The Holy Spirit wants to give you wisdom to be a consistent, faithful, and energetic employee. Your attitude should be one of servant-hood, enthusiasm, and quality. A wise employee is productive as opposed to a person with a lazy spirit who sleeps late, doesn't reach any goals and is basically unfruitful. --- Wisdom brings the ability to solve problems, and the Holy Spirit will bless your boss and give you favor with him.

4. Wisdom in your ministry --- Acts 6. If you are wise in your personal life, family, and occupation, God will reward you with a ministry. The seven deacons were selected because they were "well respected and full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom. V3. They knew their gifting and worked with all their hearts so that the pastors would be free to work in their gifting. The Holy Spirit knows our place and function. All of us are called to be able ministers of the New Covenant. We must all win souls.

(Prov 11:30) The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life; and he that wins souls is wise.

When talking about fruitfulness, Jesus said some would bear fruit 30-fold, some 60-fold, and some a 100-fold, but that everyone would be fruitful! Your assignment this week is to take this Spirit of Wisdom, this Ruach HaKodesh that is within you and go make a difference in someone's life. Blessing!

The first Hebrew Scripture use for the phrase Ruach haKodesh (or "holy spirit") in Psalms 51 contains a triple parallelism:

10 "Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit (רוח ר) within me."

11 "Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit (רוח קד) from me." "Do not fling me from Your presence", commenting: "as elsewhere, this Hebrew verb has a connotation of violent action for which the conventional translation of it as 'cast' is too tame." [1]:

12 "Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation and uphold me with a (רוח ד) free spirit."

The Holy Spirit is for everyone and for today! James 1:5-6 "And if any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that gives to all men liberally and upbraids not: and it (wisdom) shall be given him. But let him ask in faith, nothing wavering. For he that wavers is like a wave of the sea driven with the wind and tossed."
